

2018 Midge Tolerant Wheat Check List

- 1) Submit sample to [SRC's Biotechnology Laboratories](#), [Discovery Seed Labs](#) or [BioVision Seed Labs](#) for testing. Additional information and submission forms available at: <http://www.midgetolerantwheat.ca/growers/faq.aspx>
- 2) Once you have your results, submit the Refuge Declaration Form 182 to CSGA to receive your crop certificate. [Form 182](#) is available on the CSGA website (note this form also lists the acceptable ranges for each class of seed): <http://seedgrowers.ca/seed-growers/production-forms/>
- 3) You must complete the [Midge Tolerant Wheat Retailer Training](#) as it has changed. You must also sign the new Retailer Stewardship agreement at [MTWSA.ca](#).
- 4) All customers will need to sign a new Stewardship Agreement only once and that agreement will be evergreen moving forward and stored on [MTWSA.ca](#).
- 5) You can search for wholesale customers and record the volume sold at [MTWSA.ca](#). In order to search and find wholesale Customers, each wholesale customer will need to complete the [Midge Tolerant Wheat Retailer Training](#) and sign the Retail Stewardship Agreement on [MTWSA.ca](#).
- 6) There is an [animated explanation of Midge Tolerant Wheat](#) – you can watch this as a review or share with customers as an explanation of the refuge/stewardship process.
- 7) Volumes sold must be entered in the invoice section of the [MTWSA.ca](#) website.
